

NEYDL Equipment List

This is a list of stadium equipment etc required for 2024, which each hosting club should submit to their stadium in plenty of time. **Each hosting club is responsible for liaising with their stadium authorities to ensure that there are no problems on the day.**

TRACK EVENTS

Hurdles: 70m, 75m, 80m, 100m, 300m, 400m. (At least 65 serviceable hurdles)

Track distances: 100m, 200m, 300m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 4 x 100m. [N.B. No 3K or steeplechase]

Timekeepers/Judges stands (preferably)

Starters Rostrum (preferably)

Relay batons – 6 (8 div 2)

Flags red/white – 6 [3 for relay changeovers, 1 for 800m break, 1 for timekeepers, 1 set spare]

Lap Counter

Bell

FIELD EVENTS

High Jump (landing area, uprights, practice bar, 2 competition bars)

Long Jump/Triple jump Practice and competition board, preferably matt black blank board level with take-off, (plasticine, 2 plasticine rollers as before if not available) board lifters, 2 rakes, 1 spade, 1 brush, 20m tape, marking spike, watering can, sand to be dug & watered before use)

Pole Vault (starting height to be 1m 70cm) Landing area, uprights, practice bar (ie bungee), 2 competition bars, winders, hangers, bar lifters

Discus (ideally 4 of each) 0.75Kg 1.0Kg, 1.25 Kg, 1.50Kg. Cage and gates 50/100m tape & Brush, warning horn, spike

Hammer (ideally 4 of each) 3.0Kg, 4.0 Kg, 5.0 Kg. Equipment as per discus

Javelin (ideally 4 of each) 400g, 500g, 600g, 700g, 50m tape, warning horn, spike, red/white flags for validity.

Shot (ideally 4 of each) 2.72Kg, 3.0Kg, 4.0 Kg, 5.0 Kg., 20m tape, Brush, Stop board secured in place.

Staff aware of how to mark throwing circles, throwing sectors and rope off throwing sectors.

Set of scales to weigh the implements.

OTHER EQUIPMENT/FACILITIES

Kitchen or Cafeteria if available

Public address system

Room with table, two (at least) chairs and power sockets for computerised results

Changing rooms and toilets

Parking space (including space for coaches) – **NB – Starters require a dedicated parking place close to the stadium entrance in order to avoid carrying their gun on public display.**
